ScanNCut Cover Pattern by Jess Crafts

Materials:

- -½ yard of fabric (tutorial uses quilting cotton)
- -sewing machine
- -coordinating thread (visible at hem)
- -pins or clips

Direction:

- Cut two of the pattern piece, one rectangle 21 inches by 8 inches, and one rectangle of 21 inches by 12 inches. See suggested layout guide on pattern piece page.
- A straight stitch will work for this project. Always backstitch at the beginning and end to secure stitching. You can also serge the seams if you prefer.
- Pin the top edges of rectangles together along the 21" sides and with the right sides facing each other. Be sure your print is facing the way you intend and then sew along the edge.
- Pin the curved pattern piece of each side of the now larger rectangle with right sides together and be mindful of print directionality. Start by pinning the curved piece to the 8 inch section. Sew the curved pieces to the rectangle.
- Hem the bottom unfinished edge. There should be enough fabric for a double hem, if desired, for a more finished look.
